- The plant of Abroma grows wild throughout the hotter parts of India.
- In ancient times, it was used therapeutically as an emmenagogue in menstrual disorders.
- According to Materia Medica of India the root and the sap are uterine tonic and emmenagogue with black pepper given in congestive and neuralgic Dysmenorrhoea.

INTRODUCTION



- Tincture of the drug is prepared from its leaves according to class III of American Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia.

PREPARATION



- Albuminuria
- Sleeplessness
- Amenorrhoea
- Carbuncle
- Diabetes mellitus and insipidus
- Debility
- Dysmenorrhoea
- Weakness of brain.

CLINICAL



- This drug is used as an uterine tonic; in the treatment of congestion, neurotic and various dysmenorrhoea.
- It regulates the menstrual flow.

PHYSIO-CHEMICAL ACTION:



- **Dry tongue and mouth with intense thirst for large quantity of cold water** which does not relieve the dryness.
- Profuse urination day and night, with peculiar fishy odor of urine
- Glycosuria.
- DM associated with skin complaints—ulcer and carbuncles

DIABETES MELLITUS



- **Loss of flesh and weakness accompanied by burning sensation all over the body**
- **Desire to drink even after urination**

- Irregular catamenia
- blood is dark, clotted, profuse or scanty and pale amenorrhoea or dysmenorrhoea

- None of these provers had a history of leucorrhoea but during the proving yellowish white leucorrhoea with offensive odour and pain in the lower abdomen was recorded."
